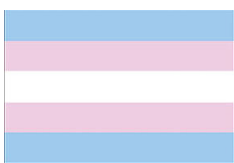


LGBTQ DOMESTIC VIOLENCE VICTIM RIGHTS

IN WASHINGTON, DC

- Under U.S. law, all crime victims, regardless of gender identity or sexual orientation, can call the police for help.
- Under U.S. law, all crime victims, regardless of gender identity or sexual orientation, can obtain a Civil Protection Order.
- You do **NOT** have to show any form of identification to file a Civil Protection Order.
- You can obtain a Civil Protection Order against someone with whom you have lived, dated, or had a sexual or romantic relationship. You can also obtain a protection order against someone who has stalked or sexually assaulted you.
- You do not have to call the police in order to obtain a Civil Protection Order.
- Victims of domestic violence of all genders and sexual orientations can access crisis housing services, legal services, and counseling services.
